<p>Wheel-Thrown Functional Ceramics*</p> <p>Wayne Smith Tuition: \$360 Mon 6:00 - 8:00pm Materials Fee: \$75</p> <p>This class will focus on making “Watering Cans” and “Planters”. Special attention will be given to functional forms, using both symmetrical and altered shapes, and learning the skills for making long spouts and a variety of handles. Great class for this time of the year... Make them, then use them...</p>	<p>Exploring Raku*</p> <p>Jill Kovachick Tuition: \$360 Wed 6:00 - 8:00pm Materials Fee: \$75</p> <p>Explore and learn the process of Raku. The student will learn various methods and techniques associated with glazes and slips. Surface treatment will vary depending on the firing. Group critiques are held each week to review and enhance concept and visual imagery. This course is designed for intermediate and advanced adult students wishing to enhance and expand their concept development in hand-building and wheel-throwing skills.</p>	<p>Beginning Wheel & Intermediate Ceramics*</p> <p>Jill Kovachick Tuition: \$360 Sat 1:30 – 3:30pm Materials Fee: \$75</p> <p>Get ready to learn the process of throwing clay on the potter’s wheel. We will be making many exciting forms from cups to bowls to beautiful vase forms. You will learn to glaze too! No experience with clay is necessary. Just look forward to having fun and exploring.</p>
<p>Hand Built Pottery: an alternative method</p> <p>Lars Turin Tuition: \$360 Sat 11am–2 pm Materials Fee: \$75</p> <p>This course is designed to give the student an alternative method of making pottery. Pieces can be made to be functional or non-functional. Challenges are limited only to the individual’s creativity and imagination. Basic construction techniques, including glazing will be discussed and demonstrated. The direction each student takes will be guided from the beginning with adjustments made along the way to satisfy personal levels of experience and prior achievements. Students will have the opportunity to develop work from creation to completion.
